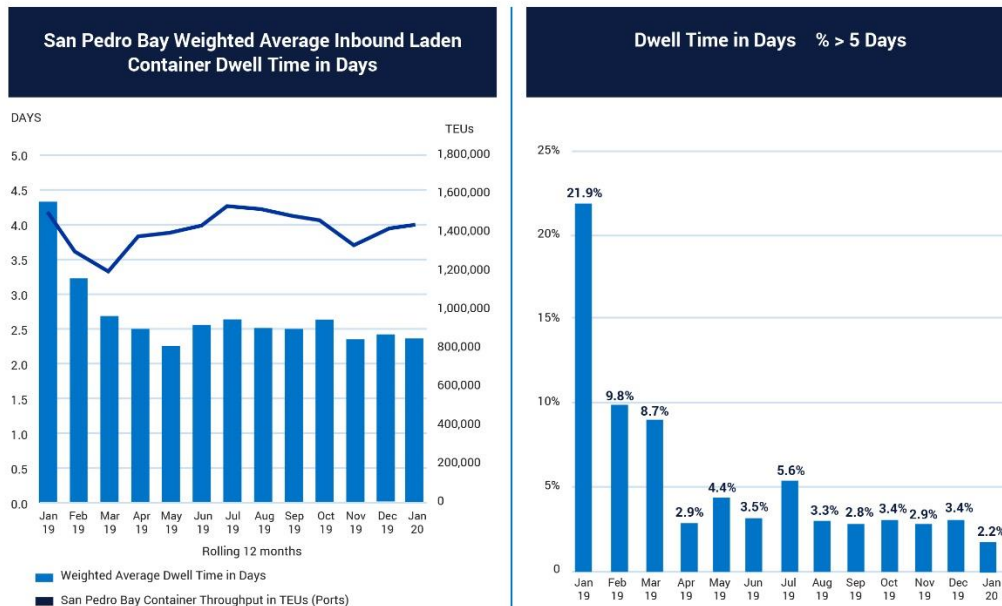

Efficient Operations Keep Container Dwell Time Low

Container dwell time at San Pedro Bay ports remained low in January, and cargo continues to move efficiently. During the month of January, containers stayed at terminals an average of 2.36 days before departing for their destination, that’s less than the 2.44 days during the month of December. Low container dwell time has been a trend for months now.

Additionally, only 2.2% of containers exceeded a 5 day stay – the lowest since PMSA began tracking container dwell time data. “The efficiency of the marine terminal operators at the Ports of Los Angeles and Long Beach is evident in the low container dwell time,” explained Jessica Alvarenga, Manager of Government Affairs at the Pacific Merchant Shipping Association. “Containers are moving in and out of these ports with fluidity.”
